CLUB UPDATE

Annual Meeting - The Annual Board Meeting this year is being held Thursday, July 20, 2017 at 6 PM in the Education Building. Club members are invited to attend to review last year's activities, treasurer's report, and a chance to meet new Board members. Results of the election for Board Seats will also be announced. Questions are always welcome from the floor, especially pertaining to the club's operation and future direction.

DEFENSIVE PISTOL

The Roseburg Defensive Pistol program has had three successful shoots this season. We started on April 1 with 20 shooters, then May 6 with 23 shooters. We have made some changes to our set up, which have worked out well and are off to another great season.

Next shoot is Saturday, July 1st with sign up between 8 and 8:30 AM, mandatory safety briefing at 8:45 and start shooting at 9 AM. If you do not attend the safety briefing, you cannot shoot. There will be 4 pistol scenarios and 1 pistol or shotgun scenario. We usually finish by noon. The fee to shoot is \$10 (cash only, please) and youth under 18 that are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian shoot for free.
