Gun & Knife Show – The September show was another overall success. All 200 tables were rented with over 1,100 attendees coming through the door on Saturday and less than half that amount on Sunday. Del Applegarth said he had vendors wanting to book the February show that day. Our next show is February 9 & 10, 2019.

Pavilion and Lower Grounds – Fall is fast approaching and that time of year when we start to think about winterizing the lower grounds. We still have a few rentals for the pavilion and surrounding area until mid-October so nothing will happen for a while. Benches will be stacked under the pavilion, and the plan is to leave the bathrooms open until such time as we feel it's getting too cold at night where it might freeze the pipes. Enjoy it while you can.

Sighting-'N-Days – Sighting-'N-Days continues until October 12th. There is still time if you're thinking about sighting in that rifle or adding a new scope. The range is open to members and the general public every Thursday and Friday from 4:00 pm to dusk, and Saturdays and Sundays from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Shooters are responsible for bringing their own eye and ear protection. Remember, all actions must be open when arriving at the range. **(No handguns allowed.)** Fees: Members and guests \$2.00. Members' children 17 yrs of age and under are free. Non-member \$5.00. Non-members' children 17 yrs of age and under \$2.00.

Indoor Pistol Range – The range remains closed due to a hold-up with our grant. However, the outdoor pistol range, Bay #1, is open every Tuesday and Wednesday mornings from 9:00 am to 11:00 am and the first and third Friday of every month from 9:00 am to 11:00 am also.

Junior Rifles - This year I do not know when Junior Rifles will start. Normally, we would start the first Monday in October. The club had put in for a grant to renovate the indoor range. We received approval for the project back in July and assumed the "check was in the mail." So we did some prep work in anticipation of receiving the grant money. We cannot complete the renovations until we receive the grant money. We took out the sand trap so the indoor range is not functional. We were hoping that we could do all the renovations before Junior Rifles started, but that will not happen. The beginning of Junior Rifles will be delayed until further notice.
