Pavilion & Lower Grounds

The board decided to modify the club's rental policy due to the ever-growing popularity, and from many requests from club members to free up the area for more member use. Starting immediately, the cost for one, two and three day rentals will be increased slightly to cover maintenance and upkeep and require those who wish to rent the facilities to become a member of the club. The board also decided to set aside the first weekend of each month for club member use. In other words, members who wish to use and/or reserve the facilities for their own purpose may do so as long as they pre-schedule or reserve the area through the caretaker first for large events. Members may continue to use the area on a daily basis. There will be no costs involved as long as you leave the area as you found it. New Road

Construction on the new road is almost complete to make it more durable. Please continue to observe current speed limits and be especially careful when passing other vehicles coming in on the opposite direction as the edges of the road are not completely set and transitions on and off the road to the caretakers parking area, archery range parking, and the club house parking lot still require additional work by raising the level to make the transition smoother and less destructive to the new road. Please do not drive on the edge of the new road if you can help it.

The front gate area still needs work. New magnetic loops located under the gate need to be installed along with the exit lane backup protection system. A separate contractor is responsible for the installation.
