CLUB UPDATE

With the government shutdown due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the club was forced to temporarily close its doors. However, the Board recently held a meeting and approved to immediately implement a reopening of the facilities in several phases and in accordance with state law.

Phase I - The “club grounds” are open for people to hike, walk their dogs, and fish, as long as they maintain six feet Social Distancing, and don’t gather in groups. They are also encouraged to wear face masks or other protection whenever possible. The club is open to members only, no guests, and for the moment, all ranges and buildings remain closed.

Phase II - Requires a plan be formed on how to reopen the ranges, while meeting the social distancing and small group guidelines. Once that plan is in place for each range, and we are allowed to reopen, ranges will open following those guidelines.

Phase III - Reopens the buildings and restrooms and requires a robust cleaning routine.

Phase IV - The club returns to normal operation, while complying with new social norms.

Dates are yet to be determined as to when to institute the various phases, based on state requirements and of course the COVID-19 infection.

Members are encouraged to use safe practices, such as frequently washing your hands, wearing a mask, and keeping social distancing. Be aware of touching surfaces, such as the gate keypad, and stay home if you feel sick.

It has been a frustrating time for all of us, but know that your board is doing their best to keep everyone safe and healthy and protecting the club and its members.
