Lakes, Ponds, Reservoirs

With the onset of winter-like weather – rain and cooler temperatures – trout fishing will slow as fish start to lay low. Look for trout in shallower waters during the warmest parts of the day. While bass and other warmwater fish don't go fully dormant in the cold months, fishing slows significantly.

- Anglers might want to check out Ford's Pond near Sutherlin. It's close to town and anglers are hooking into a few bass.
- Lost Creek Reservoir has been stocked a couple times this fall, and remains accessible even as snow limits access to other lakes. Fishing can be good throughout the fall and winter.

Rivers and streams to fish this week:

The middle Rogue has half-pounders up to about Robertson Bridge and late-run summer steelhead still available around the Galice area as well as Gold Hill to Rogue River. Try fishing nightcrawlers and corkies. The upper Rogue has been very good for summer steelhead above Shady Cove as well. River conditions should be stable into weekend, but some weather is expected. Only hatchery steelhead and hatchery trout may be retained. Anglers have been enjoying some good success with winter steelhead in the Umpqua.

Five shooters participated in the December Bench Rest Match. At 100 yds. all five shooters were able to shoot a perfect 250. In first place was Jeff Whitcomb with 18Xs. There was a three way tie for second with Whitey Williams, Buck Williams, & Wes Jackson all getting 17Xs each. At 200 yds. Whitey Williams was the only one who shot a perfect 250 with 7Xs, getting first place. Buck Williams got second with a 248-3Xs & Jeff Whitcomb got third with 247-8Xs. In the final scoring Whitey Williams was first with 500-24X's, his son, Buck Williams, was second with 498-20X's, and Jeff Whitcomb was third with 497-26X's. The next match will be on January 17th.
