CLUB UPDATE - Earl Skonberg 541.229.2700

Oregon Measure 114 is called the “Firearm Ownership and Purchase Requirements Initiative” and is on the ballot as a state statute on November 8, 2022.

If you have not read or heard of this ballot, we suggest you check it out.

A "yes" vote **supports** this ballot initiative that will:

- Require permits be issued by Oregon State Police to buy any firearms.
- Require photo ID, fingerprints, safety training, criminal background check, and fee payment to apply for a permit.
- Prohibit manufacturing, importing, purchasing, selling, possessing, using, or transferring ammunition magazines capable of holding more than 10 rounds and make violations a class A misdemeanor punishable by up to 364 days in jail, a fine of up to \$6,250, or both.

A "NO" vote **opposes** this ballot initiative thereby maintaining existing state law, which requires a seller/transferor to request a background check before firearm purchase.

• *In the best interest of the club and its membership, we highly recommend a “NO” vote on this initiative.*

Gun & Knife Show – Plan to attend the show at the Douglas Co. Fairground September 17 & 18, 2022. This is the second show of the year and expect to have a full house. Doors open at 9 am each day closing at 5pm on Saturday and 3pm on Sunday. Tickets are \$8.00 per person for a two-day pass with children under the age 12 free with a paid adult. Junior Rifles - Junior Rifles will start a new season on Monday, **October 3rd** at 6 pm, in the Indoor Range. We shoot 22 LR target rifles at targets 50 feet away. I will teach the art of competitive shooting while stressing firearms safety. The club has all the equipment necessary for competition including: rifles, spotting scopes, shooting coats, shooting gloves and shooting mats. Juniors 12 to 20 are invited to participate. Cowboy Action Shooting - Cowboy Action shoots on September 25th. We welcome new shooters, men, women and children (12 and older) who are interested in this old western shooting sport. Each cowboy will have 2 single action pistols, a lever action rifle and a shotgun, all of which would be pre-1900 reproductions. We shoot in .45lc, .38 and .22 calibers. If you are interested in seeing what we are about and would like to shoot a stage with us (or the whole match) bring your own ammunition and we'll provide the guns. Defensive Pistol Program - Our next shoot will be September 3rd. This program is designed to assist shooters with their gun handling and shooting skills while consciously positioning oneself behind cover. Five new scenarios are developed each month with targets designated as shoot (bad guys) and no shoot (good guys). Defensive Pistol is a *non-competitive* shooting program that allows each person to go through the scenario at their own pace while being shadowed by a Range Officer to ensure safety. The shoot is 5 stages, one of which will be a shotgun stage. This stage can be shot with your pistol should you not have or want to bring your shotgun. We will also have at least one stage that will be compact/subcompact pistol friendly. Typically, we shoot less than 100 rounds with our pistols and under 50 rounds with our long guns. Please bring your eye and ear protection and your guns, unloaded, magazine out of the gun and in a holster, box or bag.

Registration is between 8am-8:30am with a mandatory safety meeting at 8:45am. The fee is \$10/shooter and those under 18 are free. If you would like to show up at 7am to help set up the scenarios the fee is waived. Contact Neal Itzkowitz 541.784.8610 for details.
