CLUB UPDATE - Earl Skonberg 541.229.2700

Oregon Measure 114 was called the "Firearm Ownership and Purchase Requirements Initiative" and is on the ballot as a state statute on November 8, 2022.

If you have not read or heard of this ballot, we suggest you check it out.

A "yes" vote supports this ballot initiative that will:

- Require permits be issued by Oregon State Police to buy any firearms.
- Require photo ID, fingerprints, safety training, criminal background check, and fee payment to apply for a permit.
- Prohibit manufacturing, importing, purchasing, selling, possessing, using, or transferring ammunition magazines capable of holding more than 10 rounds and make violations a class A misdemeanor punishable by up to 364 days in jail, a fine of up to \$6,250, or both.

A "NO" vote **opposes** this ballot initiative thereby maintaining existing state law, which requires a seller/transferor to request a background check before firearm purchase.

It's crunch time! Ballot Measure 114 is on November's ballot and will cost lives, most certainly block lawful citizen's firearms purchases, and violate the rights of Oregonian's 2nd amendment, self-defense, and privacy.

Junior Rifles has started a new season. So far, I have one student. Kayla Smith returned for her second season. Up until joining junior rifles, in December, Kayla had never shot a firearm. She learned quickly and discovered she is good at it. This season she has started up where she left off last season. She is shooting in the high 90s (out of a possible 100).

Junior Rifles is about smallbore (.22 caliber) competition. I will teach you the art of smallbore competition while emphasizing firearm safety. We shoot at targets at 50 feet. We begin shooting prone. Most students shoot prone the first season. New students will generally be shooting in the 90s by the end of the first season. They then progress to kneeling and standing. Junior rifles has all the equipment necessary, including rifles and ammo. I accept students from 12 to 18 years old. We shoot on the indoor range at the clubhouse. We shoot on Monday evenings from 6 to 8 October through April.

This club event is open to the public. You need not be a club member. If you are interested in joining, please call me first as you will need a gate code to enter the property.
