Junior Rifles – The new season for Junior Rifles will start Monday, October 9th, 2023. We meet at 6:00 pm in the Indoor Range. Season runs from October to the end of April. I teach the art of smallbore competition. Smallbore consist of shooting prone, kneeling and standing. Distance to target is 50 feet. Juniors 12 years and older are

invited to join. New students will start off shooting in the prone position. As students become proficient in a position, they will learn the next position. Typically, students spend the first season becoming proficient shooting prone. The club has all the equipment necessary including: rifles, coats, gloves, mats and spotting scopes. Fishing Report

North Umpqua River – All fishing on the North Umpqua River and its tributaries is closed from July 31 through Nov. 30, 2023. Low numbers of returning wild summer steelhead prompted state fishery managers to enact the angling closure from the mouth to the marker below Soda Springs Dam. Last updated 8/2/23.

South Umpqua River (catch-and-release) - Smallmouth bass fishing on the South remains great with anglers reporting high catch rates and good-size smallmouth. Until we start seeing cooler river temperatures, this will remain a great place to catch bass. There is no bag limit or size restrictions on bass caught in the South Umpqua.
