Zachary Note (Med) won the Neophyte class with a 564 - 15 Centers and Addison Elbert (GP) was second with a 542 - 13 Centers. Paxton Fox (Med) won the Beginner Class under 15 with a 563 - 13 Centers. Carson Yraguen (RSBG) won the Beginner 15 and older Class with a 558 - 18 Centers. Kayla Smith (RSBG) won the Intermediate Junior Class with a 381 - 5 Centers. Kayla moved up in class to shoot three position: prone, standing and kneeling.

Fishing Information -No spring Chinook in Umpqua in 2024. Just a reminder that retention of wild adult or jack spring Chinook in the mainstem and North Umpqua is prohibited in 2024.

Rogue-South Coast Steelhead Validation and Harvest Tag required beginning Dec. 1. All steelhead anglers in the Rogue Basin and on the south coast will need a Rogue-South Coast Steelhead Validation from Dec. 1 to April 30. In addition, anglers will need a new harvest tag to keep wild winter steelhead in this area. Please check the regulations for wild winter steelhead harvest dates on the Rogue River as they can be different depending on where you are fishing. E-tagging tips for anglers - It's important for anglers to tag their salmon and steelhead immediately, which means you'll need to know how to navigate the MyODFW app outside of cell phone range.
