Fishing Report - Just a reminder that retention of wild adult or jack spring Chinook in the mainstem and North Umpqua is prohibited in 2024.

Umpqua river, north: Steelhead, Chinook.

Steelhead season is winding down quickly. There should still be some around, but very few hatchery steelhead can be found on the North Umpqua. Spring Chinook are crossing Winchester Dam daily, so angling should be improving.

Umpqua river, south. Steelhead runs have slowed quickly this past week. There are definitely still some around, and some still bright and healthy while others are getting darker. Bass fishing should start picking up as soon as we get some warmer weather.
